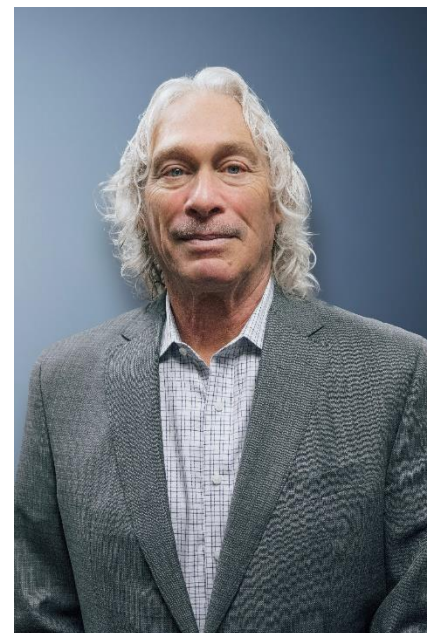

A Message from Leadership

Migrant Support

We are playing a critical role in providing migrant support through various initiatives. One way we assist migrants is by offering street feeding, where we send our food trucks out multiple times a day to distribute non-perishable food and hygiene products to those in need directly on the streets. Additionally, the food bank has extended its support to shelters and processing centers, supplying migrants with food during their temporary stay in El Paso.

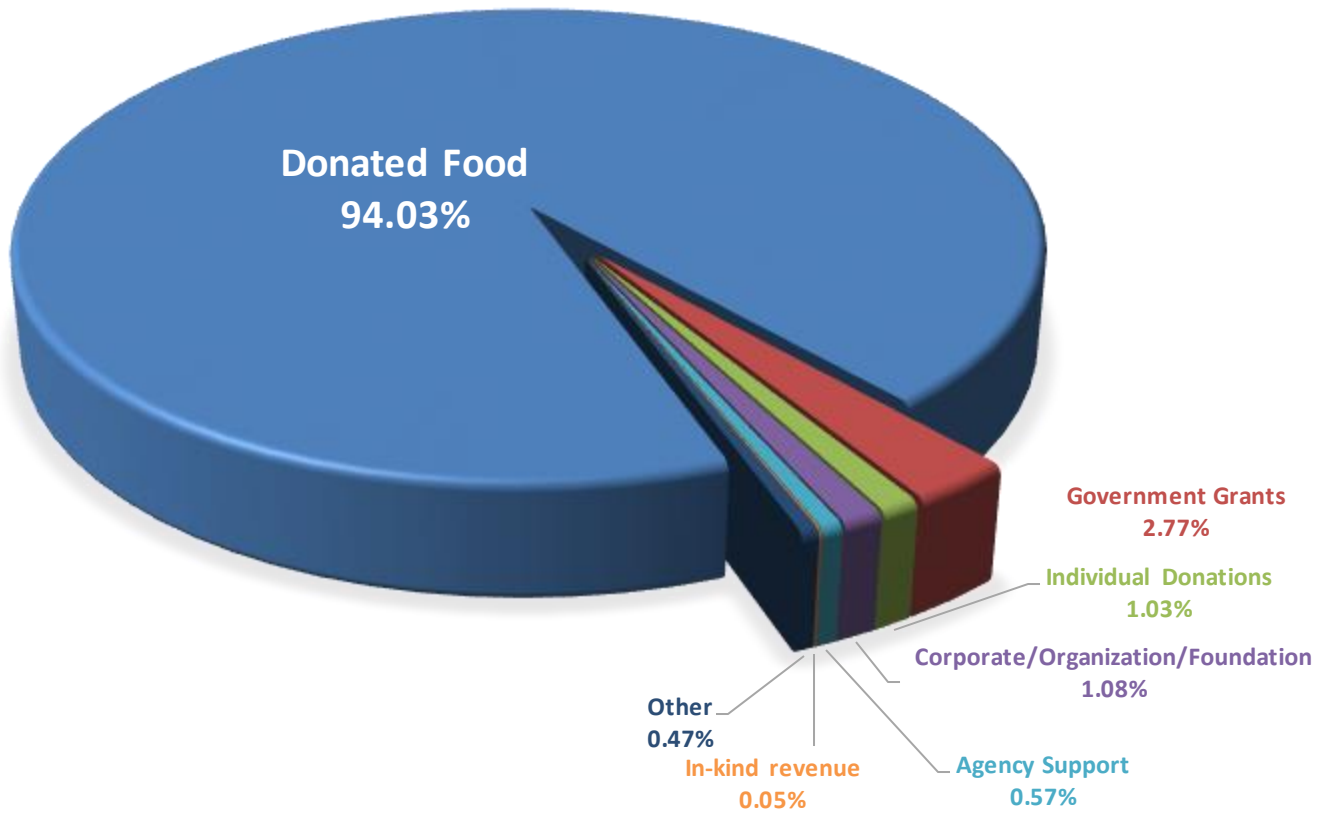

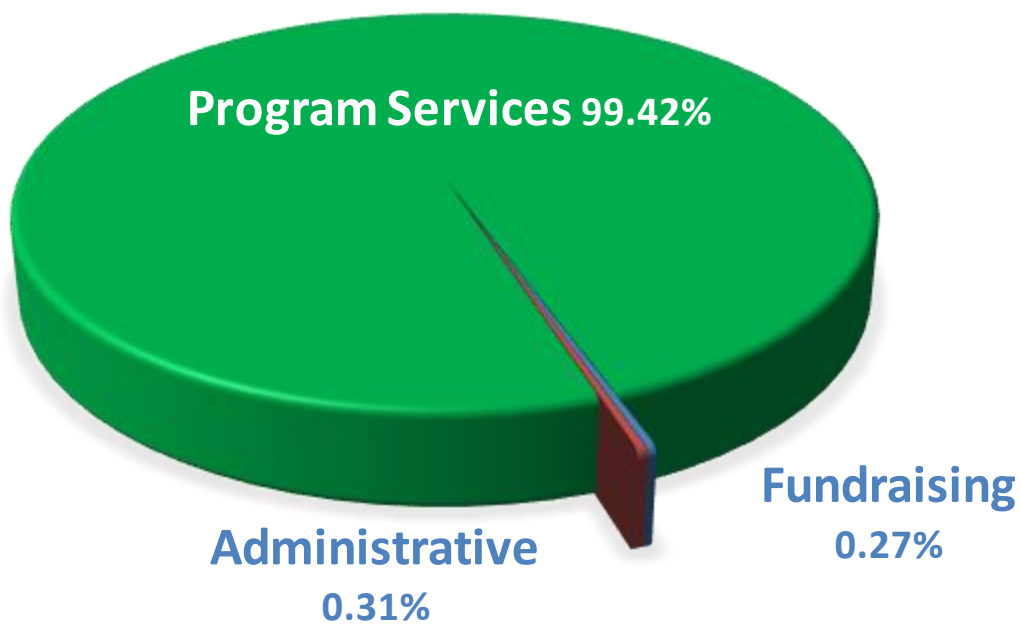
