

# El Pasoans Fighting Hunger's mission is to combat the hunger crisis in our region... because no one should go hungry.

We proudly offer the following programs:

### **Client Choice Mobile Pantries & Mobile Pantries at Schools**

EPFH uses its refrigerated trucks in collaboration with partner agencies to distribute nutritious food to a minimum of 100 families per site who live in underserved or unserved neighborhoods including colonias. Client choice allows individuals the opportunity to "shop" for food. EPFH has 818 Client Choice Mobile pantry distribution sites annually, and 164 mobile school pantries in 7 area school districts.

## Commodity Supplemental Food Program (CSFP)

EPFH introduced the Federal CFSP program to El Paso for the first time in 2018, to help address food insecurity among low-income seniors. Through this program, 5,250 extremely low-income senior citizens have access to nutritious foods which helps them maintain their health. The seniors eligible for this program generally live on incomes as low as \$750 a month.

#### National School Lunch Program (NSLP)

EPFH manages the NSLP for the Texas Department of Agriculture. This program provides nutritionally balanced, low-cost or free lunches to children each school day. EPFH serves 185,000 low-income children across 182 schools in seven West Texas counties, including El Paso, Culberson, Hudspeth, Brewster, Jeff Davis, Reeves and Presidio Counties.

## SNAP Program (Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program)

Through federal funding, our SNAP Coordinators conduct outreach including home visits, phone, and in person assistance to clients with new and declined food stamp applications, as well as connecting clients to other government benefit programs and referrals to community resources. Our service area covers some of the poorest census tracts in the nation.

## Home Delivery Program

This program is a partnership with DoorDash and enables EPFH to provide food to our most vulnerable homebound neighbors via home delivery. Through this partnership, we are able to deliver food boxes to approximately 1,700 (mainly homebound seniors) clients as resources allow.

#### Street Outreach

We partner with El Paso County Constables to feed the unsheltered homeless in our service area.

#### Migrant Support

Our mission is that no one should go hungry, including migrants released in our community. EPFH provides food to migrants as part of the massive humanitarian effort that is vital to the Borderland's health.
