

Food Processing Rooms

BEFORE

To increase our ability to accept and distribute more donated food, **El Pasoans Fighting Hunger** is investing in **three new food processing rooms.** These state-of-the-art spaces allow us to take in and repack food that other food banks might struggle to handle, such as **large quantities of frozen meat, bulk pasta, and 2,000-pound boxes of beans**.



Food FARMacy

We are playing a critical role in improving health outcomes for our neighbors through the **Food FARMacy**. This initiative provides fresh, nutritious food and education to individuals managing chronic diet-related illnesses such as diabetes, hypertension, and heart disease. Each week, eligible participants—referred by healthcare providers—receive healthy food tailored to their needs, along with guidance to make informed nutritional choices.




