In June, EPFH launched the Spark! Training Program, designed to provide individuals with the skills and certifications needed to thrive in the logistics and warehousing industry.

The program is now in its third cohort, with 20 enrolled trainees. With approximately 40 graduates thus far, the program is steadily growing and creating a significant impact in the community.

Trainees come from diverse backgrounds with unique challenges and goals. They take part in a comprehensive curriculum that equips graduates with the certification and expertise needed to excel, enhancing their employment and career prospects.

One unique aspect of the Spark! Training Program is the hands-on experience trainees gain during the eight-week session. They contribute 2,560 hours of work to EPFH's operations, playing a crucial role in our day-to-day functions. This practical experience reinforces learning while instilling a sense of purpose and accomplishment in serving the community.

While specific statistics on job placements and pay increases are not yet available, the food bank helps many of the program's graduates secure meaningful employment. In fact, EPFH itself hires some of these skilled individuals,

further integrating them into the organization's mission to combat hunger in El Paso.

As the program continues to grow, EPFH aims to expand its reach and impact, empowering more individuals with the skills and opportunities needed to build better futures. The food bank is also working to gather data on job placements and salaries for its graduates, which will provide valuable insights into the long-term benefits of the program.

The Spark! Training Program is a testament to EPFH's commitment to addressing food insecurity while fostering long-term economic stability and growth in the community. By equipping individuals with valuable skills and certifications, we're creating pathways to employment and self-sufficiency.

We look forward to the continued success of the Spark! Training Program and our graduates, and we are eager to share stories about the impact you've helped make on their lives. Together, we are building a brighter, more resilient future.

new skills, build confidence in interacting with diverse groups of people, and cultivate empathy and understanding.
